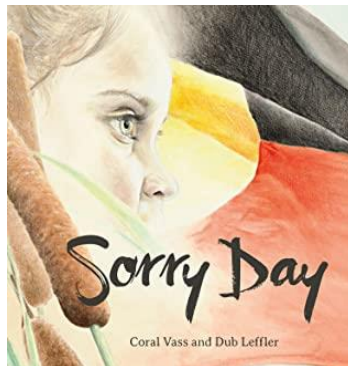


## Week 1 & 2 Year 7 Library
